## **Programme Outcome**

• PO 1: Knowledge of the evolution of literature and culture from ancient times to recent times helps students to understand the relationship between time and literature. As a result, they have a deep understanding of literary reading and literary criticism. It enables them to analyse and interpret the chemistry of culture and literature and society in texts.

• PO 2: This programme imparts a profound understanding in Bengali Language through the various stages of evolution and transformation in different perspectives. Students are then able to identify the patterns of linguistic changes and can detect the theoretical specialization of language in literary body.

• PO 3: Students of language are always inspired and encouraged to develop their writing and analytical and speaking skills. The communicative skills enable them to involve at a variety of literary works including research-oriented works.

• PO 4: Students are learned the norms and ethics of publication and data collection.

• PO 5: Finally, the programme will make the students eligible for Higher Studies and they also can apply their knowledge at other field also – i) Higher Studies (Such as M.A in Bengali or Linguistics or Comparative Literature) in reputed Universities. ii) Special Couse on journalism, advertising, print media and publishing house. These courses can also give him/ her an opportunity of employment. iii) Eligibility through examination and/ or viva as teaching faculty at primary, secondary and higher secondary schools. iv)After Graduation, students of Bengali will also be immensely suited for creative enterprises such as film, theatre, script-writing, editing and so on.
