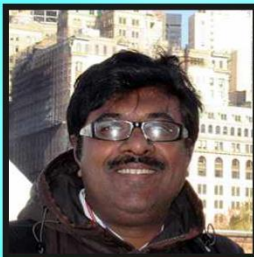

One Day Webinar On “Human Genome and It’s Various Aspects”

A one-day webinar on "Human Genome and It’s Various Aspects" organized by the Post Graduate Department of Zoology, Krishnagar Govt. College was held on 12th July 2021 at 3.00-5.00 pm. The human genome is the entire set of DNAS found in a human being. It contains all the genetic material from which an individual is made up, including their DNA structure, their genes and other genetic information, and any mutations that have occurred to their DNA over time. It was discovered in 1953 by James Watson and Francis Crick while they were working together at Cambridge University in England. They received the Nobel Prize for discovering its structure and function in 1962. The human genome has many different functions, but its primary role is to store our genetic information. This information includes everything from our physical characteristics (such as hair colour and eye colour) to how we process information (e.g., reading comprehension skills). DNA acts as the blueprint for our bodies' cells by providing instructions on how they should function. When a cell divides into two new cells, it receives instructions from its parents regarding what it should do next based on these instructions—this process is called "reprogramming" because it reprograms the cell so that it becomes an exact copy of whatever was programmed into it. When cells are damaged or die off due to aging or other causes. Understanding it as our duty to make students knowledgeable about it, Department of Krishnagar Govt.
